- 80% of people with asthma do not use their medications correctly

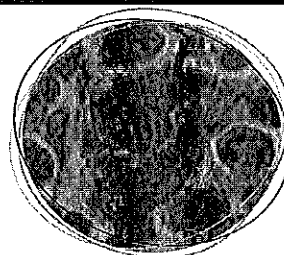
